MOOSE HUNTING

Manitoba, Canada

What better epitomizes a great Canadian hunt than the pursuit of Trophy Moose? Gage Outdoor offers some of the largest Canadian Moose in all of Canada.

Our remote area is home to HUGE bulls. Our average spread is 54" and we have taken a MONSTROUS 66" (205 B&C) and 7 others breaking the 60" mark. Every year we take moose in the high 50-inch spread range. It doesn't get any better than this!

Our terrain consists of a vast region of 5,000,000 acres with over 12 rivers and a hundred lakes. This area is exclusively ours and located almost 200 miles from the closest road. No other outfitters hunt this area and we have practiced careful conservation methods since we first opened. This mix of lakes and river, boreal forest, swamp plus the various forest fires which have run through the area have created the ideal habitat for big moose. We hunt from a variety of camps, ranging from our plush outpost camps to tent camps.

Success runs 75 - 85 %, varying from year to year, and opportunity is 85%+. We hunt by boat, traveling to different areas by water, and repetitively calling, in order to lure one to the water's edge. We hunt mornings and evenings although schedules may vary based on lake size and conditions. Hunting moose is like hunting a ghost and when they appear, they stand 8' at the shoulder and weigh over 1200 lbs. Many hunters have frozen in shock at the first sighting of such a massive animal. And, most of these animals have never seen a human, offering truly virgin hunting grounds.

This is Canadian Trophy moose hunting at its finest, offering a class of animal that can rival at times Alaska or the Yukon for size. Very few Canadian destinations can say that.





ACCOMMODATIONS

We choose the camp per the situation and utilize a vast area to constantly rotate hunts year to year. Camps hold from 1 - 6 hunters per camp and we rarely mix parties, giving you a truly customized hunt. This enables us to put you in the best situation possible for your quest for the deer family's largest member.

Our accommodations range from our deluxe ultra-modern fishing outpost camps to rustic cabins to portable tent camps. The tent camps are specially designed to cater to parties of 1-2 hunters. Each camp has communication, comfortable cots with foam, cooking facilities and a small freezer and small generator.

Laundry service is available at the main lodge for an extra fee. All outposts except the tent camps have washers and dryers.

TEMPERATURE

Weather is approximately 35-70 degrees in mid-September; approximately 25-60 degrees in late September.

WHAT TO BRING

- Cash, personal checks and Travelers checks are accepted at the outpost for payment. Visa and Master Card are accepted at the main lodge. Cash is requested for all gratuities.
- All luggage limited to 80 lbs. Extra fees are charged for overweight luggage. Gage Outdoor is not responsible for any extra costs incurred by guests.
- Travel Documents - A passport is now required for entry in Canada and return to the US. Hunters bringing a rifle or shotgun will need a "Canadian Firearms Declaration" which costs \$25 Canadian dollars and must be presented at the border. Cash or credit card are accepted. Bring proof of auto insurance when driving. Manitoba hunting requires a blaze orange hat and vest. Handguns are NOT allowed in Canada and using them is a serious offense. For hunters traveling with a felony or misdemeanor on their record, please check with us or Canadian Customs to see if this may present a problem crossing the border. Misdemeanors such as a DUI are considered a felony in Canada and will be treated as such. The age of the act is crucial to determining whether a waiver will be granted. Offenses 10 years and older usually receive a waiver and offenses 5-10 years old may be issued a special permit at the discretion of the border officer. We also work with an agency which can help navigate this process.

Hunting Clothing:

We suggest layered clothing that is quiet and an outer covering that is water-repellant. You should not be walking in much water, 8' or less when crossing a stream and waders are not necessary. A good Gore-Tex boot works but many guests prefer a good mid-calf waterproof boot for getting in and out of the boat.

- Hat/Stocking cap
- Thermal underwear
- Warm socks
- Medium weight gloves
- Good breathable rain suit
- Mid-weight coat for 35°F
- 2 pairs shoes and boots (waterproof)
- Layered clothing
- Hunting vest

- Plastic lawn bags to keep items dry in boat

- Range finder/ spotting scope
